Over three months have passed since Anna Fraser left us, and longer since most of my mornings included a phone call with a cheery greeting “ Hi Anna it’s Anna calling”. It was our little joke as we knew each other’s voices as well as our children’s.

An obituary (<http://tinyurl.com/pjz5nzi>) tells the story of a life, but not the full spirit and quality of a person. In a few short paragraphs I will attempt to capture a small part of her incredible spirit.

If one was lucky enough to have Anna F as a friend, one had an unwavering friend through thick and thin.

She never hesitated to offer her legal talents to organize a club, or organization, or write a puppy contract for a friend.

She would often offer to help before being asked. She advised and supported, loved company and entertaining. She was full of ideas and had the spirit to follow through.

She loved all things Border Terrier, especially earthdog, she was there for BT’s in need and was a force to deal with if she felt in the right about something – and usually was :). In her breeding she strove above all for health and temperament and passionately believed that a National Breed Club was the best way for Border Terrier breeders, owners and enthusiasts to connect, share information and protect our precious breed.

Anna faced her final months with strength, grace and dignity, and as always concerned about those around her the most. I miss her beyond words.

Border Terrier Canada Sweepstakes Judging Comments – August 1, 2015

Judge: Margaret Henning (Faireview Border Terriers) Prairie View, IL

I would like to thank Border Terrier Canada for inviting me to judge Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes at the club's 2015 National Specialty. This was a wonderful opportunity for an incredible road trip west, and I enjoyed the chance to see many dogs I don't normally encounter in the States.



In the juvenile sweeps classes, I was encouraged to see that the majority of the youngsters moved well both coming and going and from the side. Soundness has been a problem in previous generations, so I hope this indicates that we're moving in the right direction in that regard. Bites, for the most part, were good, with tooth size being fairly varied. Ribs were also pretty varied, and I think it's important to remember that the standard requires a rib that is carried well back.

In the veteran sweeps classes, I was impressed by the overall soundness of the exhibits. All three dogs have aged incredibly well and still look like they could put in a decent day of work in the field. I think this speaks incredibly well to the breeding programs and longevity in this breed. If only all breeds could be so fortunate.

Juvenile Sweeps – JR. Puppy 6-9 Months Male

1 400 Roschel's Chequers

Young male of good size with a pretty head but didn't want to use his ears on this day; ears could have been a touch smaller. Very nice coat and hide, decent rib, underline could have been slightly stronger, good topline, more length of body than other two puppies in the class. Rear movement could use some improvement.

2 404 Versaterre's Mister Fahrenheit

Another young dog with a pleasing head. Nice rib, shorter in body than the first placed dog, moved well around the ring, good topline and underline. A bit lacking in coat on this day.

3 401 Versaterre's Prickly Situation

Pleasing head. Littermate to the second place dog, and nice head consistency between the two. Moved well around the ring, nice topline and good underline. Coat a little lacking on this day. At this point, bite not quite where it needs to be.

Juvenile Sweeps – 12-18 Months Male

1 409 AM. CH. Sunkist Surely You Jest

Dog who caught my eye from the moment he entered the ring. Narrow, racy dog with smooth, laid-back shoulder, nice rib, nice coat and hide, beautiful topline, and good overall balance. Although he wasn't always cooperative for his handler, he moved well from all angles. Would like a stronger head. I was happy to award him Best in Sweepstakes.

2 403 Am. CH. Middleshores Walking in Memphis

Another nice young dog with an eye-catching head. More compact dog with a good coat and hide, pretty topline, moved well from all directions, nice, short tail. Preferred the overall raciness of the first place dog.

Blue bitch of very nice size. Beautiful head with lovely expression, ear could be a touch smaller, nice tail, good rear, nice overall balance, good coat and hide, moved well from all directions. Nice topline but could hold topline slightly better on the move.

Another nice blue bitch. Very showy and enjoyed herself in the ring. Pretty head, nice overall balance, moved well from all directions but would like to see her relax her head and tail down a bit on the move. Nice coat but preferred jacket on first place bitch. Preferred overall type on first place bitch.

This was another veteran in wonderful condition who enjoyed his time in the ring. Pleasing head, nice front that has aged well, nice length of body and rib, nice underline, still a very narrow dog.
