Directions: The Toners are northeast of Toronto. We recommend taking the 401 if you are located east of Toronto. For those to the west of Toronto you may take either the 401 or 407 (toll).

HWY 401: Take HWY 401 to HWY 412 north for 7.9 km. Take exit 9 for HWY 7 and turn left onto HWY 7. Continue for 1 km and then turn right onto Lakeridge Rd/Durham Regional Rd 23. Stay on Lakeridge Rd for 29.8 km and #11600 will be on the left.

HWY 407: Take HWY 401 to HWY 407. Take exit 111 for Lakeridge Rd/Durham Regional Rd 23. Drive north for 30.1 km and #11600 will be on the left.

TEST INFORMATION

The tests will follow Rules & Regulations effective January 1, 2024



ELIGIBILITY

Tests are open to all purebred Dachshunds and those Terriers in Group IV and on the Miscellaneous list seeking eligibility for Group IV that are small enough to fit into a 9 inch drain. Spayed, neutered and debarked dogs are eligible to participate. Dogs must be six (6) months or older.

TESTS

Introduction to Quarry (IQ – Not an official CKC Test) This test is a simple instinct test requiring no training or previous exposure to earthwork. Young dogs with no previous working experience and novice handlers are encouraged to enter. Open to all eligible dogs that have not completed requirements for a JE title or higher title.

Novice Earthdog (NE – optional) – This test is designed to provide a titling option for those dogs that are not yet ready for Junior but who have mastered the requirements for Introduction to Quarry. It is an elective test and dogs are not required to attain a Novice Earthdog title prior to entering Junior. The Novice Earthdog class is open to dogs who have not previously earned an Earthdog title. A dog may not enter Novice Earthdog and another regular class in the same test.

Junior Earthdog (JE) Open to all eligible dogs. A dog that has completed the requirements for JE is not required to move up to the next level but may no longer compete in IQ.

Senior Earthdog (SE) Open to dogs that have completed the requirements for the CKC Junior Earthdog title. A dog that has completed the requirements for SE is not required to move up to the next level.

Advanced Earthdog (ADVE – optional) To be eligible for the Advanced Earthdog Test a dog must have completed the requirements for the CKC

Senior Earthdog Title. This test is designed to provide an option for those dogs that are not yet ready for Master, who are not comfortable with a brace mate or who already have their Master title and are looking for a less physically challenging opportunity. A dog may not enter Advanced Earthdog and another regular class or Intro To Quarry in the same test.

Master Earthdog (ME) To be eligible for the Master Earthdog Test a dog must have completed the requirements for the CKC Senior Earthdog Title.

QUARRY: The quarry used in these tests will be two live rats.

Fencing will be placed around the IQ, Novice, Junior, and Senior test locations.

Participants using DogShow.ca will be required to sign the "Earthdog Participation Agreement" prior to competing.

Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date except for bitches in season.

TEST SITE

Bring water, shade and shelter (such as E-z Up tent or X-pen) for you and your dogs. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be **under control and on a leash at all times**, except during the test. As is the case with most earthdog tests, the ground at the site is uneven. Wear appropriate footwear.

Dogs must be on a 6' leash, flexi-leashes and long lines are not permitted.

No smoking is permitted at any time on the grounds.

The Border Terrier Club of Ontario and Border Terrier Canada will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs, the exhibitors, the spectators and the quarry, but will not be responsible in the event of any accident to dogs, exhibitors, spectators or quarry.

Exhibitors and spectators are required to respect all signs posted on the property. Exhibitors and spectators are also reminded these tests are being held on private property and we are here at the pleasure of our hosts. Children need to be under strict supervision at all times. Out of respect for our competitors, if their behaviour is disruptive, you will be asked to leave the property.

Please pick up after your dog(s) and yourself.

PARKING

Parking will be available within the grounds. Please follow signs and parking attendant's instructions to the grass parking area.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. If you pay by personal American cheque, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Do not write “Payable in Canadian Funds” or “At Par”. This is not acceptable and will not clear the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to buy bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Or use DogShow.ca.

BORDER CROSSING: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate, and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Please be aware of current CDC requirements for returning to the USA.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Owned Dogs): For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born/owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering a first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog’s foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (Canadian funds) along with the completed application form. The form can be downloaded from www.ckc.ca/forms or from the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC *Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations* are available from the Canadian Kennel Club at 1-800-250-8040 and online at www.ckc.ca

CKC REGULATION 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CKC Non-member Participation Fee: An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a CANADIAN non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to become a CKC member or pay the non-members participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

MOVE UPS: Move ups are permissible one (1) hour before the class provided that the dog is not already entered in that test.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

AWARDS: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry, Novice, Junior, Senior, Advanced, and Master Earthdog tests will receive rosettes.

TEST PRECINCT: The precinct of this test will be the marked section of ‘The Toners’, Sunderland, ON. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

VALIDATION OF ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, with entry fees, signed including Participation Agreement. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the tests.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian’s certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the test, must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.
